

## 2022 Band Day Schedule

**6:30–7:30 AM**      **Band Day Check-in at Carr’s Hill Field —OR— on Culbreth Road**

*You can check-in one of two ways. Park in the Culbreth Parking Garage and Check-in on Carr’s Hill Field –OR– Drop-off your student on Culbreth Road and check them in carside.*

**7:30–9:10 AM**      **Cavalier Marching Band (CMB) + Honor Band (HB) Rehearsal on Carr’s Hill Field**

**9:10–9:50 AM**      **Breakfast for CMB and HB students on the Drama Building Lawn**

*Tubas and Drums: Set your instruments in cases by the Truck near the Parking Garage.  
Drummers: You will bring your harness and drum stand with you on the bus.*

**9:50 AM**              **Honor Band students load buses, depart for Slaughter Recreation Center (SRC) escorted by CMB Supervisors**

*HB students should bring their instrument/flag and personal items on the bus to Slaughter Recreation Center  
Tubas are transported to Slaughter via a CMB truck.  
Drums are transported to Slaughter via a CMB truck; Drummers should transport their harnesses and drum stands on the bus*

**10:20 AM**              **Arrive Slaughter Recreation Center (SRC)**

*Store all instruments and personal items in the areas designated by instrument.*

**10:45 AM**              **CMB Supervisors guide HB participants to Scott Stadium, Section 104**

*When you depart SRC, bring only your instrument, your music, and a coat to keep warm.  
Leave all other personal items at the SRC.*

**11:50 AM**              **From Section 104, watch the CMB perform its Pregame Field Show**

**12:00 PM**              **Kick-off vs. Pittsburgh**

**12:00-3:30 PM**      *3 Courtesy shuttle buses will run between SRC and the HSBB.*

**Approx. 12:45 PM**      **CMB Supervisors escort HB participants to the tunnels to stage for the Halftime Show (Beginning of Quarter 2).**

*HB Tubas, Drummers, and Color Guard members: you will enter the field via the stairs at the front of section 104.*

**Approx. 1:15 PM**      **Load Scott Stadium Tunnels to prepare for Halftime!**

**Approx. 1:30 PM**      **Perform CMB's Veterans Appreciation Halftime Show**

**1:45 PM**                **Return to Section 104 for second half of Football Game**

*We will utilize two different sets of stairs (northeast and southeast corners of stadium. More information will be shared at the morning rehearsal.*

**3:15 PM**                **Game ends**

**3:30 PM**                **Band Day Check-out process begins**

CMB Supervisors escort HB participants back to Slaughter Recreation Center.

- Authorized Individuals sign-out their HB Participant @ the SRC
  - Supervisors verify authorized individuals' identification, collect signatures
- Courtesy shuttle buses (12) are available to take Participants and Parents/Guardians back to the Hunter Smith Band Building

**3:30–4:30 PM**      **Drums and Tubas are loaded onto a CMB Truck, driven back to the HSBB**

*Drummers and Tuba players should be checked out at the SRC and ride the courtesy bus back to the HSBB. Your instruments will be available for you to pick up once the truck returns to the HSBB.*

**4:30–5:30 PM**      **Courtesy buses and trucks continue to run between SRC and HSBB for HB Participants and family members.**

### **Section 104: Check-out At Any Time**

Authorized Individuals have the option to check-out their student(s) at Scott Stadium in Section 104 at any time during the game.

- An Authorized Individual presents identification to one of our CMB Supervisors, and signs their student(s) out

- Slaughter Recreation Center will be monitored throughout the game by a CMB representative. You're welcome to walk back to Slaughter to retrieve personal items
- Courtesy shuttle buses will be available at SRC to take you back to the Culbreth Parking Garage.
